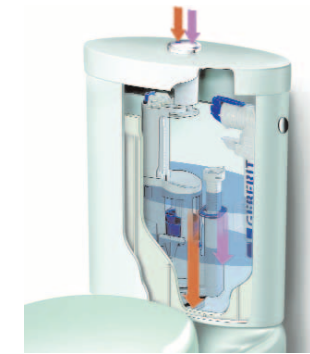


Saving water the clever way.

Toilets from LAUFEN save water. They are tested and approved as low-consumption 6-litre units in accordance with the EN 997 standard. They use a maximum of 6 litres per flush and achieve perfect results. A four-person household thus saves 25 000 litres of valuable drinking water per year when compared with a conventional 9-litre economy cistern. The flushing systems used by LAUFEN all come from Geberit, one of the world's leading sanitary technology companies.

Perfect hygiene and function.

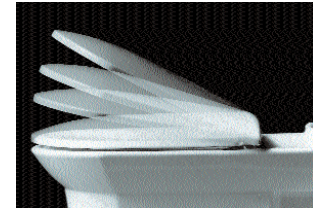
Ceramics are already a «clean» material, but LAUFEN has managed to make it even more hygienic thanks to a series of new developments.



The aesthetic Clou overflow system means that sinks and bidets no longer need an overflow, which can harbour dirt over time.



The installation bracket developed by LAUFEN allows the front panel to be removed quickly for thorough cleaning.



The lowering mechanism ensures that the WC cover and WC seat land gently on the bowl.

For easier cleaning, the seat and cover can be simply removed with a flick of the wrist.

Antibacterial coating: LAUFEN WC seats are treated with an antibacterial and antimycotic substance which is not superficial, but penetrates the material thus durably preventing the spread of bacteria.



WonderGliss makes cleaning the ceramics particularly pleasant. The smooth ceramic surface makes for simpler and better cleaning.



LCC (Laufen Clean Coat) is a unique non-porous ceramic surface which is resistant to dirt. LCC is economical, low on abrasion and thoroughly hygienic thanks to the smooth "glaze-on-glaze" effect.
